MAKE_UP SHOULD BE AGE APPROPRIATE AND IN GOOD TASTE. The Miss will compete in gown, personal interview, fashion-wear and self-introduction. The Mrs. will compete in gown, self-introduction, personality interview, fashion-wear and swimsuit.

AREAS of COMPETITION:

Gown competition will be the dress of your choice. Tiny Miss and Little Miss must wear short or tea-length dress. Junior Miss, Teen Miss, Miss and Mrs. Must wear long dresses. No bare midriffs and dresses should be age appropriate. As you come on stage in gown competition, you will go to the microphone and introduce yourself-include name, age, school, grade, etc. Time limit of introduction – 45 seconds and no longer. Points will be deducted for going over the time limit.

Fashion-wear competition will be the outfit of your choice-it is for judges to see you in a high fashion choice of your own. No hats, no taking off jackets, etc. Upbeat music will be played during this event.

Personality interview will consist of a 5-minute interview panel style. The interview will give the judges an opportunity to get to know you. Please relax and do not be too rehearsed or programmed. Interview will be held on the morning of the pageant at a predetermined location. This competition is to assure that Miss and Mrs. Wesley Chapel are well-spoken representatives.

Swimsuit for Mrs. category only will consist of a one or two- piece swimsuit in a solid color. The contestant will be judged on her commitment to physical fitness.

All contestants will not be allowed to wear gloves or hats during any competition.

The **entry fee** will be **\$65.00** along with a **\$25.00** ad (business card size) sold to a business or family to give well wishes. All checks are to be made payable to **Greater Wesley Chapel Chamber of Commerce.** **All fees are nonrefundable.**

Whether you have participated in this pageant in the past or this is your first year, every contestant has a fair and equal chance to become a winner. Judges are carefully selected and will be totally impartial and qualified. All decisions of the judges will be final. If you cannot accept this, please do not enter. The contestants and the parents should show good sportsmanship at all times. If this is not followed, the contestant will be disqualified.

Only contestants will be allowed backstage on the night of the pageant. There will be plenty of pageant staff that can help the contestants. Please do not bring valuables backstage because no one will be responsible for damage or theft of these items. The Tiny Miss and Little Miss must come dressed with hair complete. Junior Miss, Teen Miss, Miss and Mrs. must have hair and make-up complete prior to arrival and will be able to change in the dressing rooms provided.

This year our community campaign of choice is **“Pounds for Pets”**. Each contestant is required to bring a 3 or 4 lb bag of cat or dog food. The newly crowned queens will donate the items to the Humane Society. **Meeting dates April 13th and 20th.**
